Drama, Power and Intrigue

During the month of January, Pastor Bill will bring a series of messages in the Auditorium called *Beneath the Surface (Lessons from Esther)*. Here's how one commentary introduces the book of Esther:

"Drama, power, intrigue – this is the stuff of which best-selling novels are made. But far from a modern piece of fiction, those words describe a true story, lived and written centuries ago. More than entertaining reading, it is a story of the profound interplay between God's sovereignty and human will. God prepared the place and the opportunity, and his people, Esther and Mordecai, chose to act."

Throughout the Scriptures, whenever God's people have been in trouble, He often delivers them through miraculous signs and wonders. Not so in Esther, where there is no mention of God whatsoever. And so the story of Esther shows us how God often works through ordinary events and not just by miraculous intervention. May we come to recognize this in our own lives. Most importantly, may we choose *to act* in response to what God is looking to do in each of our lives.

In the Chapel Pastor Ray will bring a series of messages called Faith Builders for 2018 throughout the month of January.

Jesus was astonished when a centurion approached him and exhibited faith in Him. Jesus' response is found in Matthew 8:10 "I tell you the truth, I have not found anyone in Israel with such great faith."

Have you ever desired to have greater faith or greater trust in Jesus? God works in various ways to build and grow our faith. Here are four ways that we will be looking at during the month of January:

- Applying Jesus' Teaching to Your Life (Matthew 7:24-27)
- Keeping Good Company (Proverbs 13:20)
- Practicing Private Disciplines (Mark 1:35)
- Engaging in Personal Ministry (Mark 6:35-44)

Christmas Eve – A Look Back








Any giving that you want to be credited to 2017 must be received in the church office no later than 9:00 A.M. on Tuesday, January 2, 2018.


